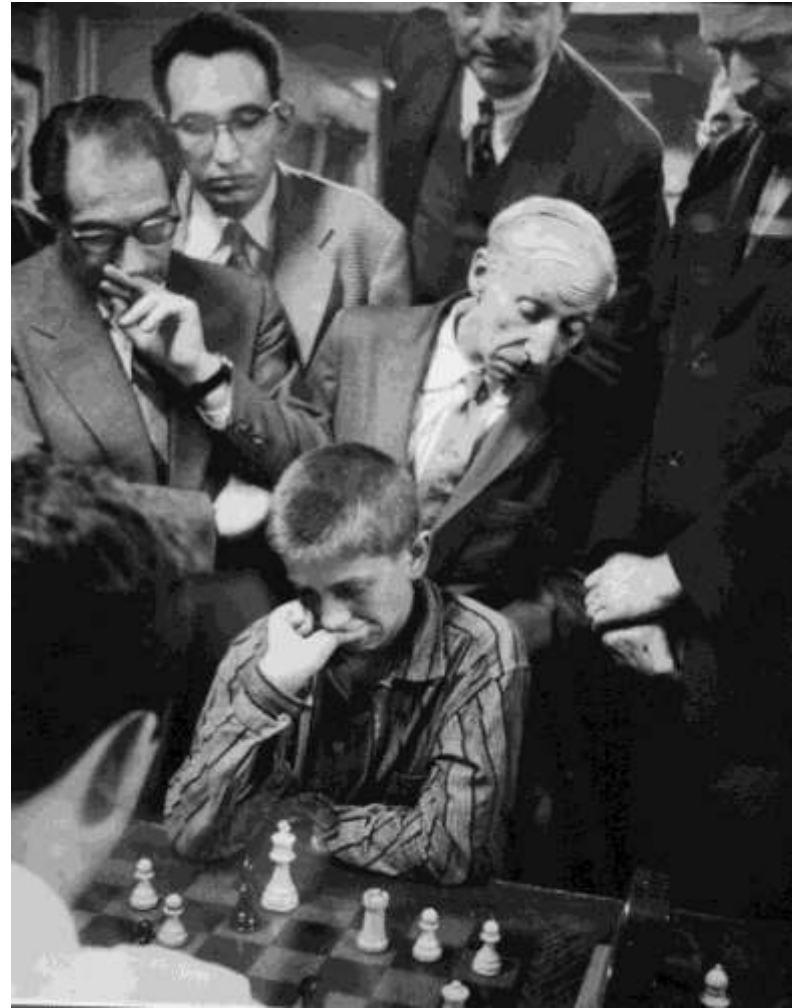

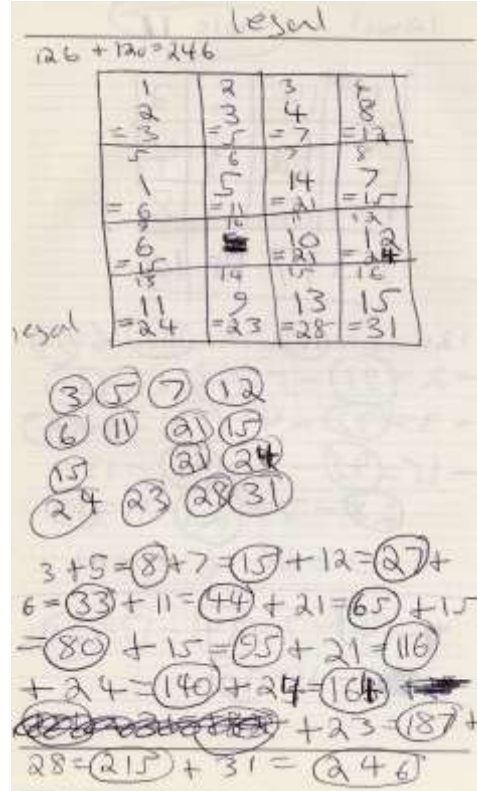

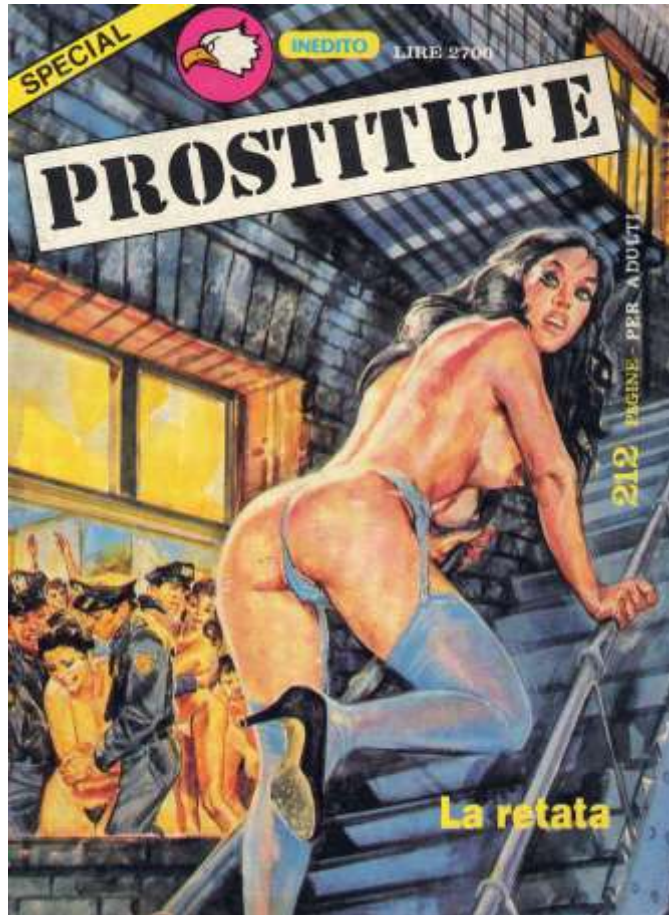

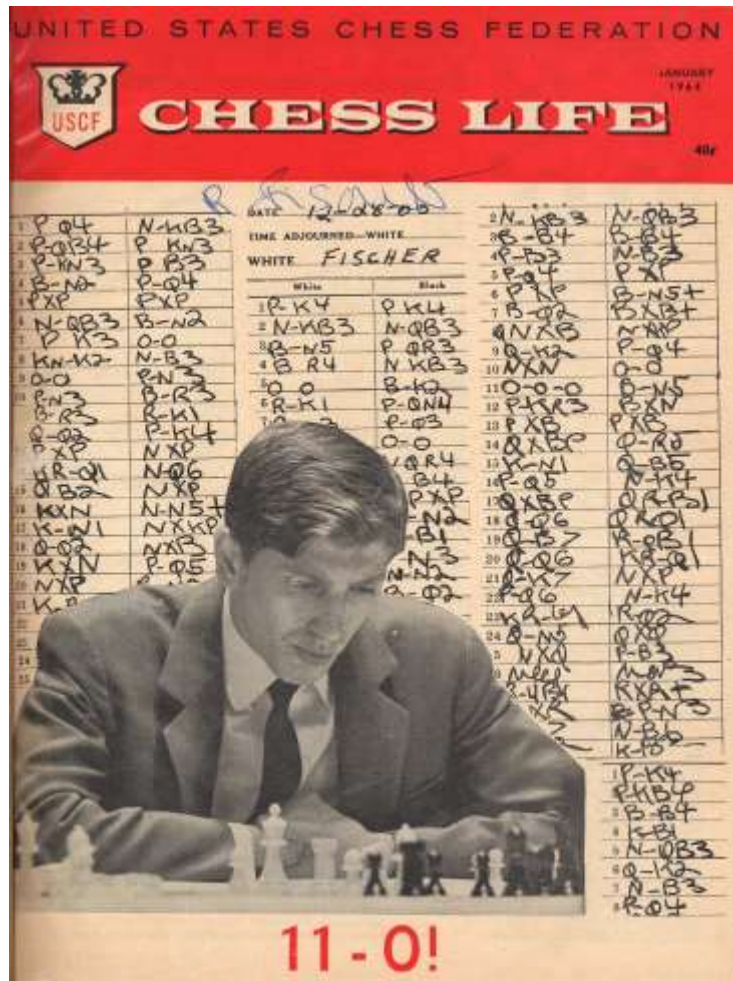

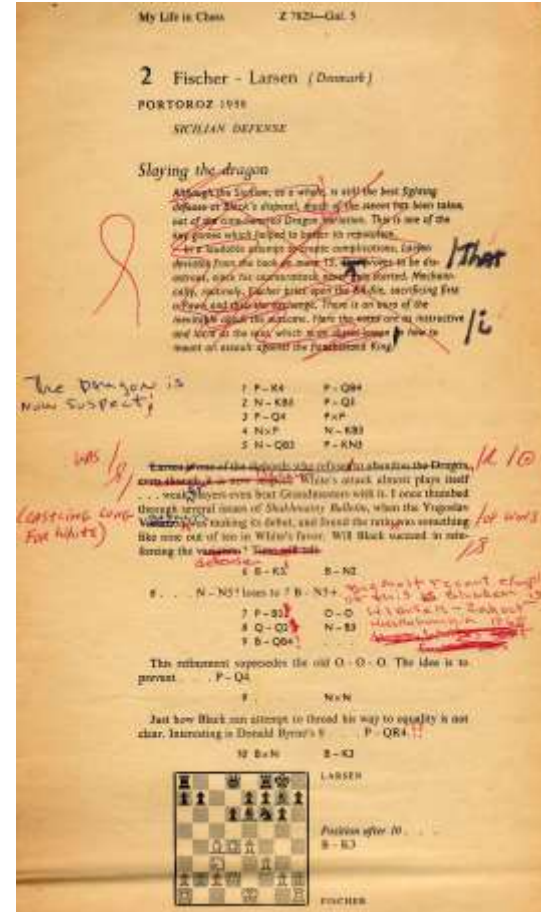

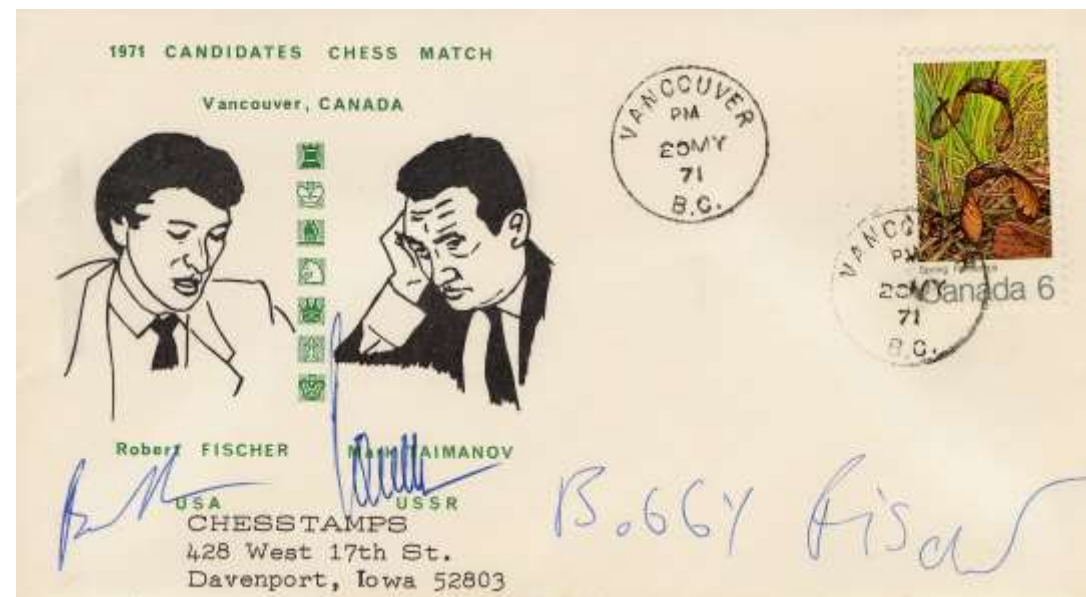

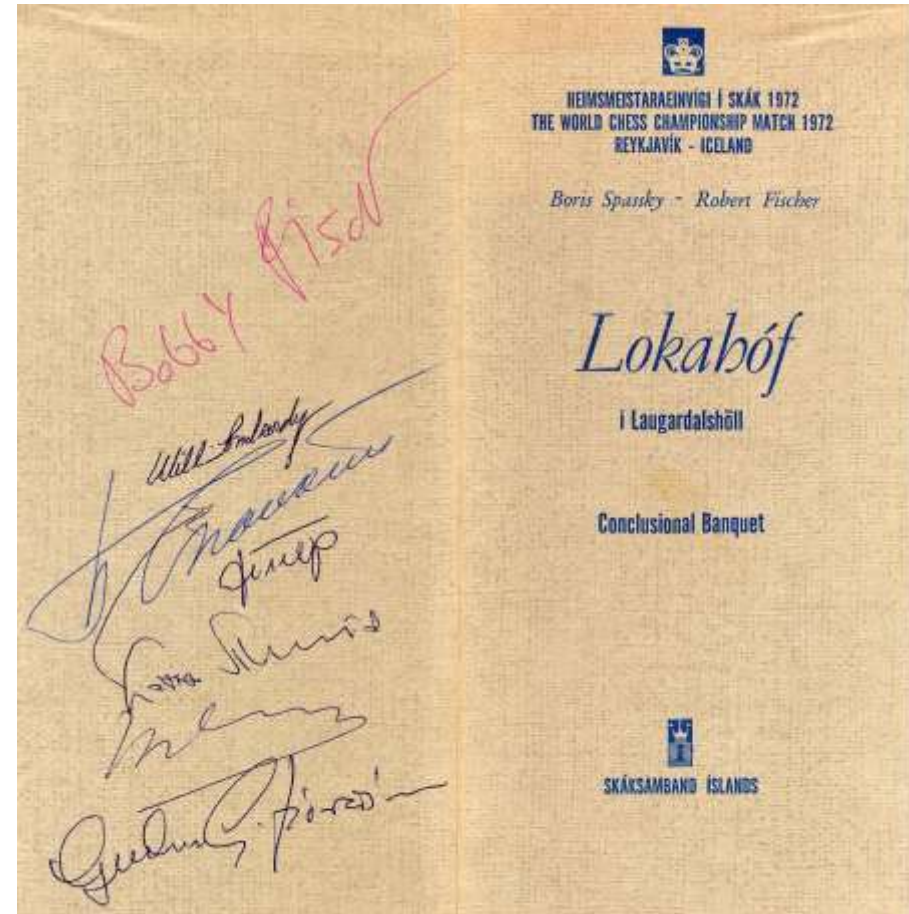
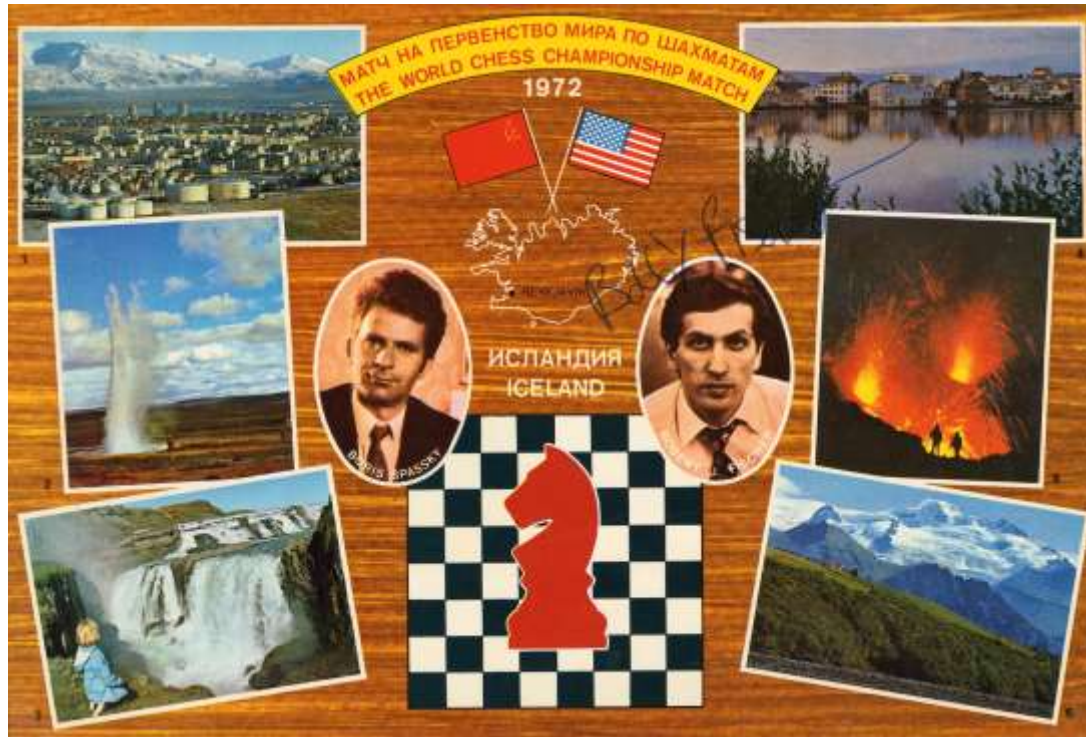
Botvinnik was never

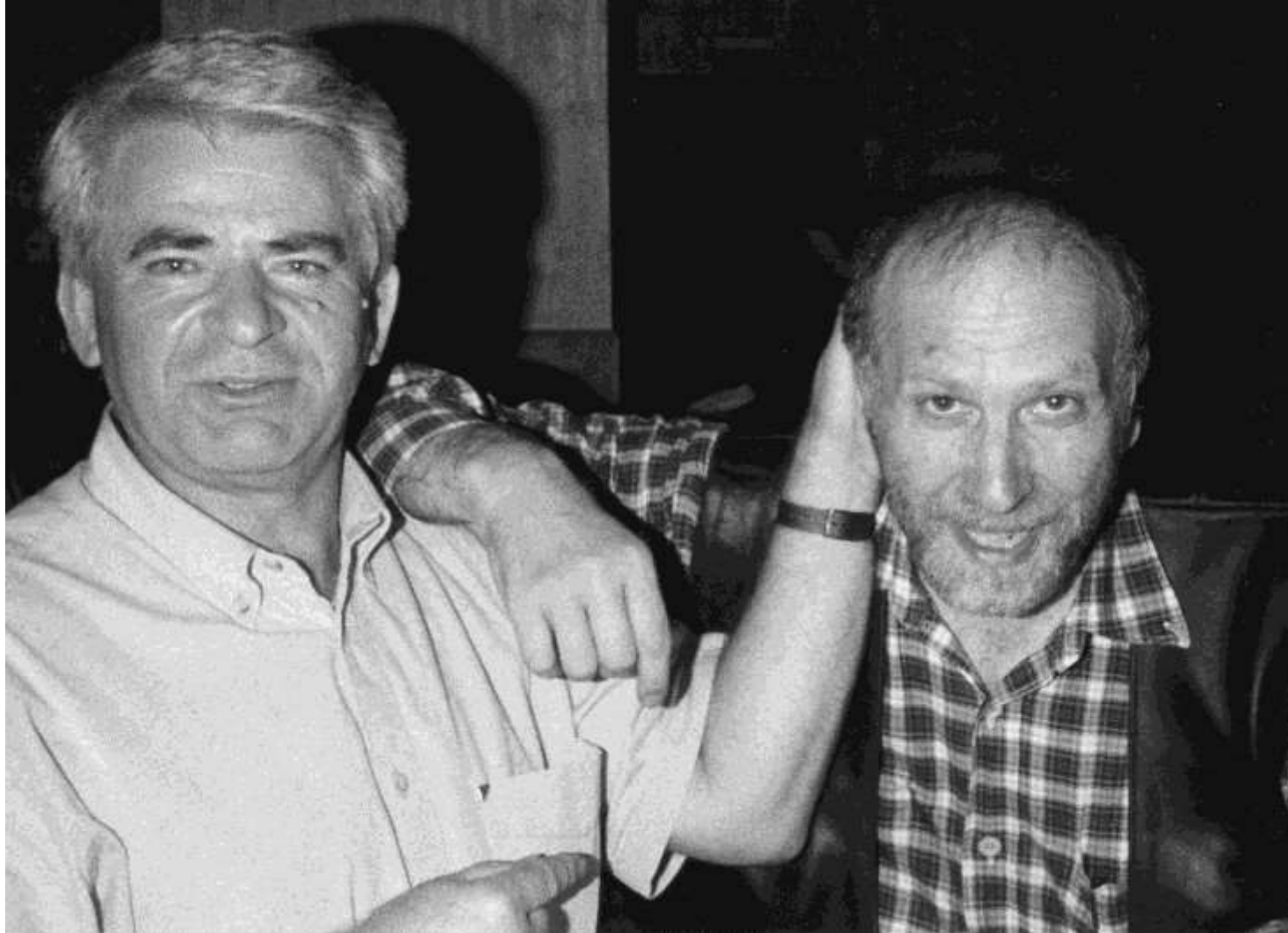
